

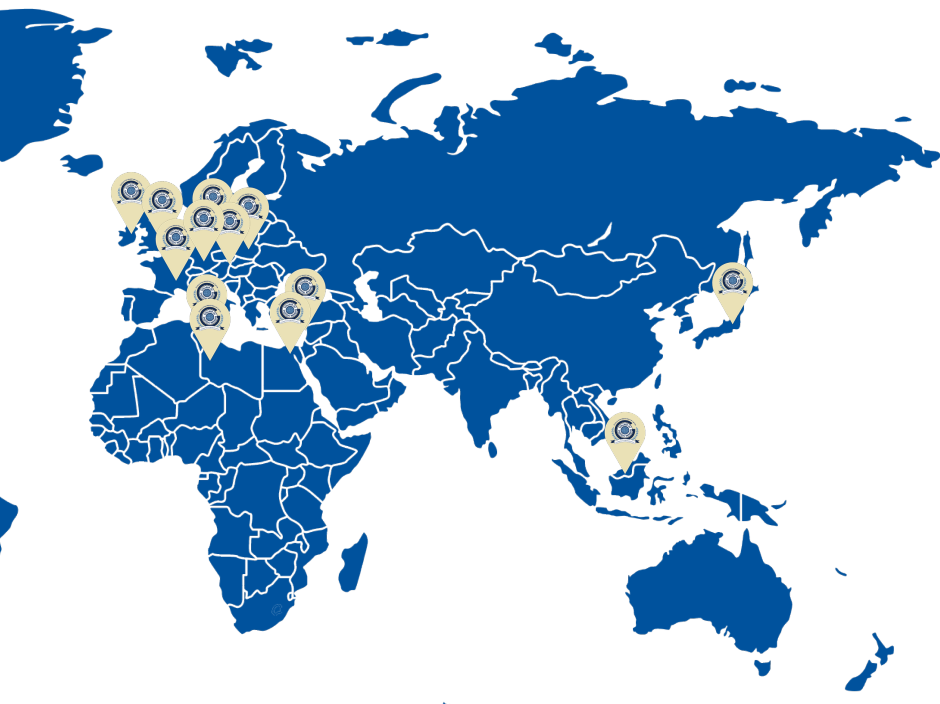

## THE GLOBAL INTERDEPENDENCE CENTER – SOLVE LONG COVID INITIATIVE PROGRAM SERIES: LONG COVID: RESEARCH, POLICY, AND ECONOMIC IMPACT

The Global Interdependence Center, in partnership with the Solve Long Covid Initiative (SLCI), conducted a year-long webinar and conference series exploring the pandemic's long-term healthcare, policy, and economic impact, specifically the implications of long haul COVID or long COVID.

Throughout 2022, GIC and SLCI brought together world-class immunologists, medical experts, policymakers, and economists to explore critical insights into defining, diagnosing, optimizing treatments, and healthcare policies for long COVID and analyzing its impact on U.S. and global labor markets. This series included **six webinars**, and a **signature event in New York City on May 19**, in addition to panel discussions at other GIC events reaching **1,000+ event attendees** and **8,500+ individuals** through video replays.

Members of the Global Interdependence Center are an integral part of our neutral, nonpartisan forum to expand awareness, advance shared interests, and promote social stewardship.

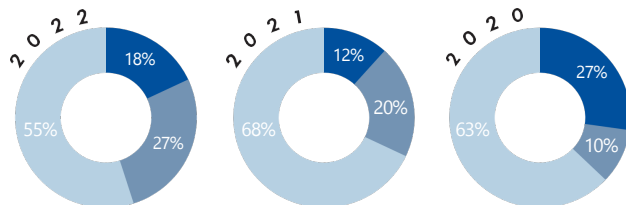
